To amend title 49, United States Code, to require an active USDOT number to conduct operations of certain commercial motor vehicles, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Registration Enforce-
5 ment for Vehicle Operations of Known Evaders Act” or
6 the “REVOKE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ACTIVE USDOT NUMBER REQUIRED.**

2 Section 31134 of title 49, United States Code, is
3 amended—

4 (1) in subsection (a) in the second sentence by
5 striking “a USDOT number” and inserting “an ac-
6 tive USDOT number”;

7 (2) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
8 section (f); and

9 (3) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(e) ACTIVE USDOT NUMBER REQUIRED.—

12 “(1) IN GENERAL.—No employer or person may
13 conduct operations requiring registration under this
14 section or chapter 139 of this title without an active
15 USDOT Number.

16 “(2) DETERMINATION.—The Secretary shall
17 only issue an active USDOT Number to an employer
18 or person seeking registration under this section or
19 under chapter 139 of this title after the Secretary
20 determines that the employer or person meets all of
21 the requirements for registration.

22 “(3) INACTIVATING USDOT NUMBERS.—The
23 Secretary shall immediately inactivate the USDOT
24 Number of an employer or person issued under this
25 subsection if the employer or person does not have
26 any valid registration issued under this section or

1 under chapter 139 of this title; or, if the employer
2 or person failed to make any periodic update re-
3 quired by the Secretary.”.
