Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the Village of Clarksburg for Sanitary Sewer Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Clarksburg (Municipal Government – Public Wastewater Utility) located at 10849 Main Street, Clarksburg, Ohio 45651.

The funding would be used to address the failing sanitary sewer lines and address deficiencies at the wastewater treatment plant that are resulting in Ohio Environmental Protection Agency violations and polluting the stream. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Village is a low-income community that needs grant funds to help get this much-needed project done and to help make the system sustainable. Furthermore, this will help the Village obtain a safe and reliable sewer system that is not inundated with infiltration and inflow and polluting the local streams.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
